Sports Premium 2016/17

Priorities:

1. To improve the expertise and confidence of all staff in delivering outstanding PE lessons.
2. Promote a healthy and active lifestyle.
3. Increase level 1 (extracurricular clubs and intra school competitions) activities and opportunities throughout the school.
4. Increase level 2 (inter school competitions) opportunities for all children throughout the school including SEN and G+T. Including 'B' team competitions.
5. To increase the number of children reaching National Curriculum expected levels in swimming.

1. CPD for staff

We are employing an experienced Physical Education teacher to work with staff on a co-coaching basis for one half day a week. This will enable all teaching staff in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 to improve their expertise and confidence when delivering PE lessons to their classes.

We also have two teaching assistants with PE expertise who work with the teachers in KS1 and KS2 to provide high quality PE lessons.

2. Healthy and active lifestyle

A variety of events are being put into place to encourage all children to lead an active and healthy lifestyle. This includes having Edge Hill University students come in to lead a 'Healthy Body' workshop, a 'Fit for Life' Adult and Family Learning Course and bikeability training for year 5.

Play leaders from KS2 also take turns to be on the KS1 playground, organising and encourage physical activities during lunch times.

Furthermore, we have provided each class with an extra ½ hour of PE per week at the beginning of lunch time, which is a high-intensity, physical session. These are delivered by Mr Swift and outside agencies.

On Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th May we held our annual Sports Days for Reception, KS1 and KS2. A variety of athletic and sporting activities were delivered followed by racing finals at the end.

We are holding two School Games afternoons on Wednesday 5th and Wednesday 12th July for KS2 children, which is an intra school competition. This will involve the children playing in their house teams against each other in a variety of different team sports.

5. **Swimming**

We continue to invest more money into swimming lessons to increase the percentage of children who have reached the recommended level by the end of year 6. Due to this increased funding, we are now in the position to offer children in Years 4 and 5 an earlier opportunity to start attending the sessions, giving more time to practise and become more confident swimmers.
