

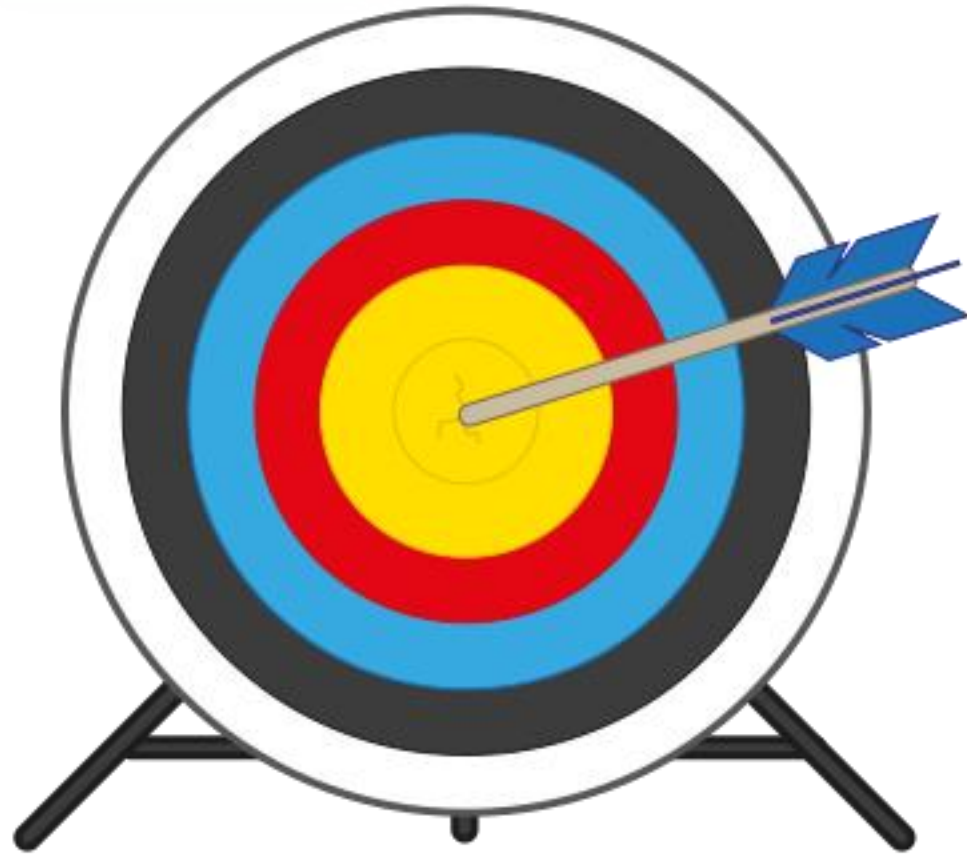

## Aims






**To encourage pupils towards an understanding of people's beliefs, values and practices, therefore developing a respect and sensitivity towards others.**

values.



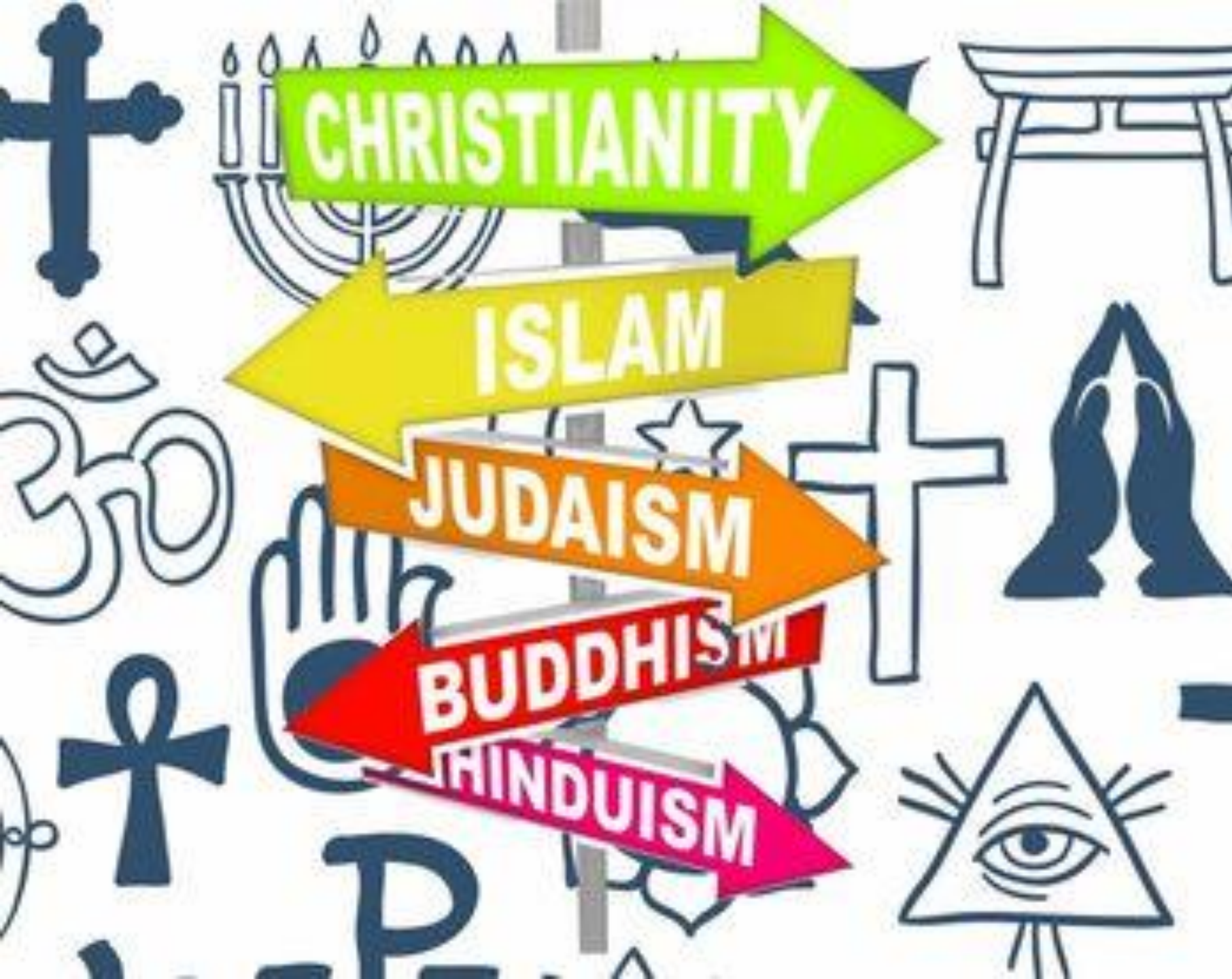
